- → 38% of CEOs are pursuing generative AI initiatives, as they believe the technology will give their organisations a competitive advantage.
- → 70% of CEOs have had their businesses disrupted by Al or think it will be in the next 18 months.
- → 30% of global spending is also set to be on generative AI in 2027, according to the report.
- → 1 in 3 firms cite poor-quality and poorly labelled data as a blocker to higher success in AI.
- → 28% of firms cite the inability to access the required data sets as the top factor preventing them from achieving higher success in generative AI projects.
- → 1 in 3 firms find that inadequate infrastructure performance and availability is the greatest factor preventing them from achieving higher success rates in their generative AI projects.
